This series of Seminars will address the following questions

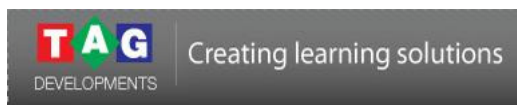
- How to bridge the **skills gap** and cope with the increasing numbers and the demands of industry, customers and the economy?
